

Year 6 learning experiences











Last half term, Year 6 enjoyed designing and making Tudor sweetie bags, investigating how light travels, learning how to play 'classroom jazz' on the glockenspiel and visiting the Tower of London.

What will your child be learning about this half term?

In **English,** we will be reading, 'Can You See Me?', 'Hansel and Gretel' and 'Small Things'. We will be writing in different genres including: an informative interview about autism, a fairground description, a synopsis and a descriptive setting. We will be focusing on learning the following grammar rules: To use a range of devices to build cohesion, to identify formal and informal sentences, to understand passive and active voice and to use colons and semi-colons.

In **maths**, we will be focusing on converting measures, properties of numbers and area, perimeter and volume.

Our topic in **science** is working scientifically.

Our **learning quest** this half term is 'How does the location of a county affect its existence?' We will be focusing on learning skills in geography such as: deepening their understanding of the term physical and human features and comparing the UK, Brazil and Iceland.

In **DT** we will be making mini carnival toys using construction and mechanical skills. In **music** our focus will be on listening, singing and performing based on Benjamin Britten's Friday Afternoon.

In PE we will be practising basketball skills and Outdoor Adventure Activities (OAA).

In RE, we will discuss questions related to Christianity.

In French we will learn about school life and food.
